

# Larson Lake Ski Trail

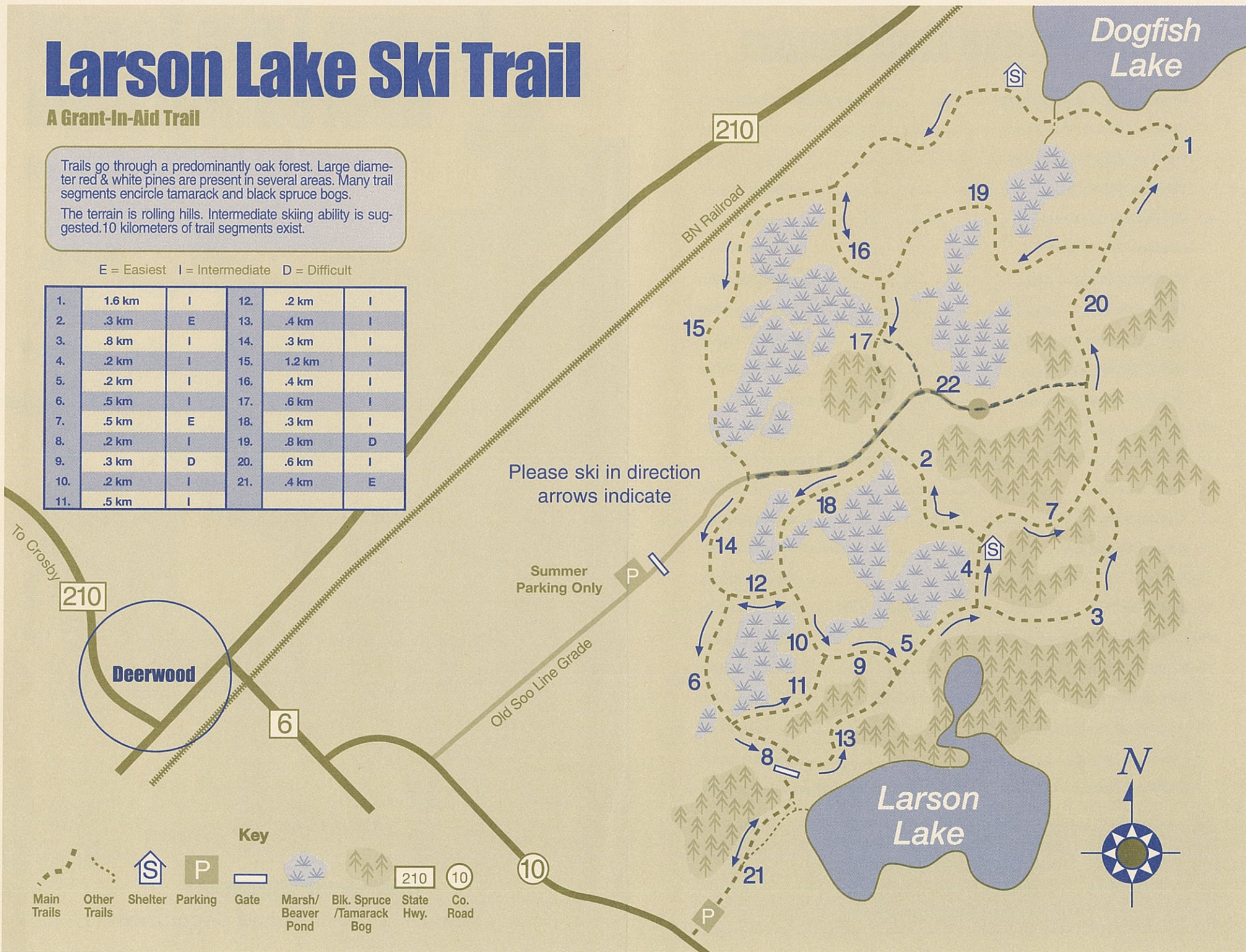
## A Grant-In-Aid Trail

Trails go through a predominantly oak forest. Large diameter red & white pines are present in several areas. Many trail segments encircle tamarack and black spruce bogs.

The terrain is rolling hills. Intermediate skiing ability is suggested. 10 kilometers of trail segments exist.
